Teaching notes: Have the children experiment with different ways of wobbling. Create some anticipation as you start "We're gonna..." Include some directional language such as high, low, up, down, in out. Try loud/soft, fast/slow wobbling. Have fun freezing when you get to the word STOP!

Musical skills:

Beat - wobbling in time to the beat

Dynamics - loud and soft

Pitch - singing a simple melody

Other skills:

Following instructions - stopping and starting

Imagination

Directional language

Extension (for older children):

Have the children come up with some different ways of wobbling and leading the group.
